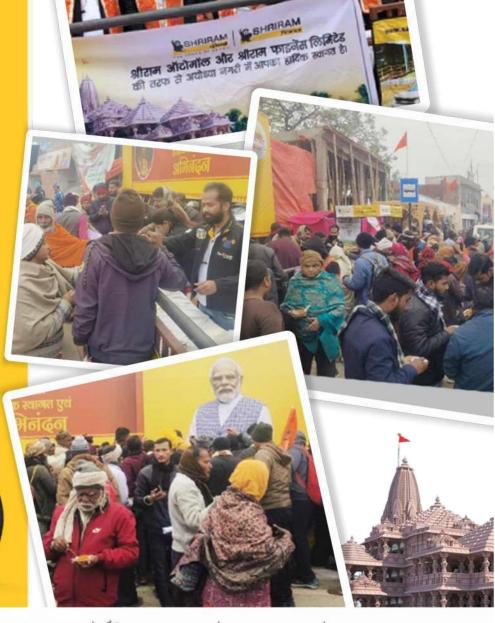
## **MOTORCYCLE SALES 300CC** TO 500CC DECEMBER 2023

#### **COMMERCIAL VEHICLE RETAIL SALES DECEMBER 2023**

The commercial vehicle market saw a marginal increase of 1.3% in December 2023, with 73,896 units sold compared to 72,944 units in the same month of the previous year.

However, there was a decline in sales from November 2023, when 84,856 units were sold. Tata Motors remained the market leader in commercial vehicles, selling 26,205 units in December 2023, but it also experienced a drop from 27,743 units in December 2022.

The year 2023 saw a positive trend for the auto industry in the country, as most car makers increased their sales and market shares. The total number of passenger vehicles sold in the previous year was 40,98,180 units, which was 8.4% higher than the 37,80,168 units sold in 2022. This meant a volume growth of 3,18,012 units.

## **LUXURY BUYERS MOVE FROM DIESEL TO ELECTRIC**

Luxury car buyers in India are shifting away from diesel and opting for petrol and electric vehicles. The report reveals that diesel's share in luxury car sales has fallen from 80% to 35% in the past five years. Electric vehicles, on the other hand, have seen their share increase to 6% of luxury car sales in India last year, which is three times higher than the average for all cars. The report expects this trend to continue as more electric models are launched and customers become more aware of their benefits.
