## ELECTRIC TWO-WHEELER MARKET MAY CROSS 1 LAKH MARK



The electric two-wheeler industry in India is gearing up for a festive boost, as it expects to sell 35–40% more units in November, breaking the previous record of 1,05,000 units in May 2023. The industry has already seen a robust growth in the first half of the season, with October 2023 sales reaching 75,000 units, almost matching the levels before the full subsidy regime was introduced.

## 2W RETAIL SALES OCTOBER 2023



The two-wheeler segment witnessed a 12.60% decline in retail sales in October 2023, compared to the same month last year. However, there was a 14.91% increase in sales from September 2023 to October 2023. The festive season in October 2023 did not boost the demand for two wheelers as expected. A total of 15,07,756 units were sold in October 2023, while 17,25,043 units were sold in October 2022, a difference of 2,17,287 units.

## TOP 10 MID-SIZE SUVs OCTOBER 2023

The mid-size SUV segment saw a robust growth of 33.08% YoY in October 2023, with 31,354 units sold compared to 23,560 units in the same month last year. The segment also registered a 14.87% MoM increase from 27,295 units sold in September 2023.



## CV RETAIL SALES OCTOBER 2023



In India, October 2023 was a remarkable month for the CV segment. It registered a 10.26% YoY increase in sales, with 88,699 units sold compared to 80,446 units in October 2022. MoM sales also rose by 9.77% from 80,804 units in September 2023. All CV makers on this list showed a YoY growth and all segments, including LCVs, MCVs and HCVs, performed better.
